Our youth development programme, which includes our Academy and Development squads is hugely important to us here at Northampton Town Football Club. Over the past few seasons, several players have come through the programme to be handed professional contracts and many of them have gone on to play for our first team. All too often, players and parents get blinded by the opportunity to go and be part of an Academy set-up at a big Premier League club. They love the thought of saying "my son plays for xx". However, the chance for a young player to break through into the first

team squad at a Premier League club, dominated by international players, can be quite small and they often end up being released and lost to the game.

Young players have a far better chance of carving out a professional career for themselves at a club where they have a realistic chance of breaking into the first team squad and where their footballing and personal development is looked after by top level coaches. This is very much the situation here at Sixfields.

Player Performance Pathway

Our Player Performance Pathway is an integral part of our Progressive Youth Development System. As a club, it is our passion to develop local players and develop them to train and play games for Northampton Town. It is our aim to allow all players to join our sessions at the Foundation Level and via our Skills Centres. Our expert coaches, who work within our Academy System will provide the essential advice and environment for players to learn and enjoy their football whilst learning individual technique and ball mastery.

Players who achieve a high level of ability will be invited to join our prestigious Development Centres. Located within the local communities, our Development Centres are a perfect opportunity for players to continue with their local club whilst also training with our expert Academy coaches and playing games for Northampton Town, helping them develop and to take their game to the next level. These centres are run for players aged between U7-U14 throughout the week. As players progress within the Development Centres, they will have the chance to progress into our Shadow Squad. The club runs shadow squads from age U7-U16 and play regular games, including against our Academy teams. The function of this player pathway is to provide local players for the Academy who have the potential to then move on to our first team.

The success this pathway benefits from is down to the use of expert Academy coaches at all levels who understand how to develop players, while maintaining maximum enjoyment.




