From The South

Leave the M1 at Junction 15A and take the A43 towards Northampton. Continue straight on and the stadium will appear on the right.

From The North

Leave the M1 at Junction 16 and take the A45 towards Northampton. Continue straight on and the stadium will appear on the right.


Travelling by public transport?

Northampton Railway Station is two miles from Sixfields Stadium and is roughly a 30 minute walk. After proceeding through the ticket barriers keep to the right passing W H Smiths. Go down the steps and at the bottom turn right onto the road. Keep going past the BP garage and at the lights, with the Thomas A Becket pub on the opposite corner, turn left into St James Mill Road. Continue down to the traffic lights with Jewsons on the left and turn right into Harvey Reeves Road which becomes Edgar Mobbs Way. Continue on here until you come to the Sixfields Stadium.

There is also a taxi rank outside the railway station if you head towards the rear entrance in to the car park.

You can also get the bus from the railway station, with D1, D2, D3, 15, 18, 55 and 87 all going to Sixfields. These buses also go from the Northampton Bus Interchange/Drapery.

We also have a bike rack available where you can secure your bike. This is located outside the stadium next to our home ticket collection booth at the bottom of the West steps.

SUPPORTERS WHO REQUIRE ASSISTANCE



Facilities for Supporters Using Wheelchairs

The club has a number of positions for wheelchair user supporters together with a seat for a personal carer if required. These are situated in front of each of the stands at Sixfields.

Wheelchair using applicants should ideally be accompanied by a person who is capable of supporting their needs in the event of an emergency and for this reason Northampton Town Football Club strongly recommend that this person is sixteen years of age or above and of good physical and mental health. We also have reusable ponchos available when it rains.

Facilities for Supporters with Visual Impairments

Audio commentary is usually available for supporters who are visually impaired, a headset can be booked by email at elliot.stonhill@ntfc.co.uk - live commentary can also be heard via BBC Radio Northampton.

The club strongly recommends that a person who is fully able to support their needs in the event of an emergency should accompany each visually impaired person attending a match.


Guide Dogs are allowed into the stadium but we would recommend that supporters with Guide Dogs contact the club before the match so that we can discuss with them access to the ground, facilities inside the ground and the welfare of the Guide Dog before, during and after the match.

Facilities for Supporters with Ambulatory Disabilities

We recognise that there are considerable numbers of people in the community who use wheelchairs mainly for outdoors mobility purposes but do not always use a wheelchair. There are also many people with severe walking difficulties who may wish to watch a match.

For the purposes of this policy both categories of people will be termed 'ambulant disabled supporters' and those supporters with ambulant disabilities of a severe nature will have access to seating nearest the entrances/exists.

Eligibility to these areas will be dependent on providing proof of disability (as described above) or will be decided on individual cases based on information provided to the Ticket Office or the Club's Disability Liaison Officer; this information will assist in determining each individual's suitability for use of the facilities.



SUPPORTERS WHO REQUIRE ASSISTANCE



Facilities for Supporters with Medical Conditions

Any supporter suffering from a condition which prevents them climbing large numbers of steps should be able to request a seat in the most accessible part of the stadium (i.e. nearest the entrances/exits). Please advise the ticket office of this request at the time of booking.

Facilities for Supporters with Learning Differences

Supporters with learning differences can normally be accommodated in any part of the stadium in normal seating. However, if, for whatever reason, any person with a learning difference feels that ordinary stand seating would be unsuitable for them, they will be entitled to sit in the disabled areas and may qualify for a free helper ticket.

Family Seating

Northampton Town Football Club recognises that disabled people have families who may wish to attend matches as a family unit in much the same way as non-disabled people would. The Club will try and accommodate such requests although this may not always be possible due to a limited number of suitable seats.

Please contact the ticket office for assistance in obtaining tickets as close as possible to the designated areas.

Car Parking Facilities

Northampton Town Football Club has a limited number of disabled persons parking places for home and away fans that are allocated to Blue Badge holders on a first come first served basis which need to be booked in advance via email to wendy.lambell@ntfc.co.uk. There is also a drop off point close to the club store.

PURCHASING ETS

Online

You can book a match ticket online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week over at ntfcdirect.co.uk. The only time this won't be possible is from 12pm on a home match day. When booking online you are able to avoid the ticket collection queues by getting an e-ticket sent straight to your mobile device if you prefer.

Ticket Office

You can purchase a match ticket from the ticket office, with the opening times currently 10am-5pm Monday to Friday, 9am-noon on away matchdays and 10am-KO, re-opening at the full-time whistle on home matchdays.

Over the phone

You can purchase match tickets over the phone at any time the ticket office is open. You can contact the ticket office on 01604 683777.

Collections

You can collect your tickets during ticket office hours during the week. Collections will be based in the ticket office at Sixfields Stadium. On a matchday the ticket collection point will be in the portacabin opposite the ticket office.

Pricing

Adult - £24 Under 18 - £12 Senior - £20 Under 14 - £8 Under 21 - £20 Under 7 - FREE

Ticket prices will increase by £1 if purchasing on the day. Buying in advance is recommended.





The club store is located at the front of the West Stand towards the main entrance to the Edgar Mobbs Way.

The club store opening times are below;

- 10am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday
- From 10am until kick off on home matchdays (closed after the game on evening matches)
- Usually from 9am to noon on away match Saturdays (away matchdays advised by social media)
